

The following are some of the many items needed by the Foundation for Exceptional Kids and the organizations we support...

## Treasure Box Items

Small items that can be used to reinforce good behaviors and reward children during therapy and in the classroom, such as stickers, pencils, fidget toys, tops, birthday party prizes, and small inexpensive toys (ie: cars, happy meal prizes).

## Equipment

As technology changes we need to stay up-to-date with items both in the classroom and the office, like desktop and laptop computers, monitors, smart boards, and ipads.

## Toys Used in Play Therapy

Play therapy centers on interactive play between therapists, teachers, and children. Specifically we would use games and any toy that generates dramatic play, such as a doll house, dress-up clothes and props, or items for playing house.

## Art and Sensory Supplies Used in Play Therapy

Markers, modeling clay, gallons of glue, paint brushes, tempura and finger paint, shaving cream, and moon sand.
